TRAVEL KENNEL

- ☐ IATA-Compliant travel kennel
- ☐ Food/water cups that latch onto the inside of the kennel door
- ☐ Crate pad (less than 3 inches thick)
- ☐ Pee-pee pads (optional)
- ☐ Thin blanket, t-shirt or towel that smells like home (less than 3 inches thick)
- ☐ CareTags (if you have purchased them through us)

PLEASE DO NOT TRY TO SEND ANYTHING OTHER THAN THE ITEMS LISTED HERE.



FOOD

- ☐ Zip lock baggies with enough food for any boarding, possible flight delays, and/or transit stops. (We can only send a few servings - not an entire large bag.)
- **Wet food is allowed only if in an unopened can.**



MEDICATION

We can NOT send medication with your pet unless you have discussed this with us well in advance, we have received a letter from your vet, and this has been pre-approved with the airlines.

If you try to send medication with your pet without telling us, the airline will remove it and it will not be shipped with your pet.

It is strongly recommended that you make sure you have extra prescriptions at your destination in case the medication does not arrive with your pet.



PAPERWORK

FORBIDDEN ITEMS



-  Bedding more than 3 inches thick
-  Toys, bones or treats
-  Litter boxes, litter or shredded newspaper
-  Unapproved medication
-  Airtags or other tracking devices
-  Leashes/harnesses (these can be misplaced)

DO NOT SEDATE YOUR PET!!!

We will NOT ship any pet that has been sedated or tranquilized and the airline will turn them away at check-in.
